#### **Product Description**

An environmentally friendly cleaner that is safe to use on all surfaces. **Neutral Cleaner** is the ideal cleaner to use for the regular maintenance of sealed and unsealed surfaces.

## CLEANING WITH NEUTRAL CLEANER

**Before commencing cleaning, it is a requirement to test first before use.**

### Surface preparation

1. Sweep or vacuum the area to be cleaned to remove any loose debris.
2. Protect carpet when using indoors.

### Testing instructions

Test first in an inconspicuous area to ensure competence and satisfaction.

Follow the how to use guide below.

**Note:** The testing phase is extremely important as it allows you to determine if you are satisfied with the results, while also allowing you to familiarize yourself with how the product works.

### How to use

1. Dilute at 10 parts clean water to 1-part **Neutral Cleaner**.
2. Spread the solution over the area to be cleaned and allow the product to stand for at least 2-5 minutes before scrubbing.
3. Agitate the area with a nylon scouring pad (a **Spirit Doodle Bug** is ideal.) It is recommended to use a firm bristled nylon or natural brush to get into the grout joints. Do not let the solution dry, add more if it starts to dry out.
4. Remove the dirty water with a dense mop, or if available, the best method is to use a wet vac.
5. Allow the area to dry completely to see the results.
6. When cleaning large areas, be sure to change the solution in the bucket every 20-50m<sup>2</sup>.

### Precautions

7. All surrounding areas that are not intended to be cleaned should be protected from contact with the cleaner.
8. Appropriate gloves must be worn during application.
9. Wash hands with soap and water after use to remove any residue that may be on the skin.
10. In the event of an unwanted spill, wipe up with a clean cloth and rinse with water.
11. Regardless of the surface to be cleaned, conduct a test first.
12. **DO NOT** use **Neutral Cleaner** on humans or animals, it will strip protective oils from the skin.

**Coverage** Depends on the porosity of the surface, temperature and method of application.

1 litre of **Neutral Cleaner** will clean approximately 20-50m<sup>2</sup>.

Clean up tools after application with water.
